

# MEET RULES AND INFORMATION

1. The competition will be held under A.S.A. Laws and A.S.A. Technical Rules of Swimming. **This event is LEVEL 2 LICENSED by the ASA for entry into National and Regional Championships.** Officials will be from National and Regional lists of the ASA. (2EM9068).
2. The fastest six swimmers in each age group in the heats of the 100m events will compete in finals. The 200m, 50m & IM events will have heat declared winners.
3. The events are:  
100m all 4 strokes 10,11/12,13/14,15/Ov (heats and finals)  
200m all 4 strokes all age groups (heat declared)  
4 x 25m I.M. all age groups (heat declared)  
4 x 50m I.M. all age groups (heat declared)  
50m all 4 strokes 9/Over single age group (heat declared)
4. The age groups are:  
9/10yrs, 11/12yrs, 13/14yrs, 15/Over, and 9/Over  
**Ages as at the 26<sup>th</sup> April 2009, Note age 9 swimmers cannot compete in the 100m events.**
5. The Pool length is 25m, six lane, and will be equipped with electronic timing with full display and anti-wave lane ropes.
6. Awards will be given to the top three placed swimmers in each age group in each individual event.
7. In addition to the individual event awards there will be the following overall awards:  
A **Top Team** award  
A **Best Supported** Team award  
**Top three Boy/Girl** awards in each of the following ages:  
9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14yrs Boys using BAGCATs  
9, 10, 11, 12, 13yrs Girls using BAGCATs  
15yrs and Open Boys calculated using GB CATs  
14, 15yrs and Open Girls calculated using GB CATs
8. Heats will be swum with all age groups combined and swimmers seeded by entry times. **Entries must be within (ie equal to or faster than) the published consideration times, but slower than the published Upper Limit Cut Off Times** for each event. These entries will be accepted on a **first come first served basis.** If similar amounts of entries are not received for each session, the start time of the later sessions on each day may be subject to change (earlier or later) and will be confirmed with the return of entry information. However, if a session is excessively oversubscribed relative to the other sessions on the same day, the promoters reserve the right to reject some of the slowest entries, at their discretion. If this is necessary, the numbers accepted for each age group will be kept to the same proportions as the number of entries for each age group. For this purpose the 9/Over events will be assessed by the following age groups, 9/10yrs, 11/12yrs, 13/14yrs and 15/Over.
9. Over the top starts may be used at the promoters discretion.
10. The Entry Fee is £4.50 per event. All entries must be on the official entry form (photocopies accepted), and **MUST** include the entrants ASA registration number together with all entry fees. No entries will be accepted after the closing date or during the meet unless due to promoters error or omission. Cheques to **CITY OF DERBY S.C.**
11. Closing date for entries is **26<sup>th</sup> March 2009.**
12. Competitors times will be computer processed and results sheets will be on sale at 50p per session. Full sets can be posted at a cost of £3.00
13. Spectator admission prices:

The overall awards will be calculated as follows:

## **Top Boy 9 to 14 / Girl 9 to 13 years**

BAG Points will be calculated for all swims by swimmers in the 9 to 13/14 years ages. These points will be accumulated into the appropriate BAG Category for each individual year age for both Boys and Girls. The overall top three swimmers in each of these BAGCATs will receive a Top Boy/Girl award.

## **Top Boy 15 and Open / Girl 14, 15 and Open**

GB Points will be calculated for all swims by swimmers in the Boys 15 and Over and Girls 14 and Over ages. These points will be accumulated into the appropriate GB Category for each individual year age for **Boys 15 and Open** and **Girls 14, 15 and Open.** The overall top three swimmers in each of these GB Categories will receive a Top Boy / Girl award.

## **Top Team**

Event Points will be scored for all events

The scoring will be:

1<sup>st</sup> 6 points, 2<sup>nd</sup> 5 points, 3<sup>rd</sup> 4 points,  
4<sup>th</sup> 3 points, 5<sup>th</sup> 2 points, 6<sup>th</sup> 1 point.

Event points will be accumulated for all swimmers (from all age groups), for each Club. The overall Top Club will receive a cash award.

## **Best Supported Team**

This award will be made at the discretion of the promoters.

If there is a tie for any of these awards then the prizes will be shared.

14. Pool Side Passes are available to bona-fide Coaches Supporting competing swimmers. They include a Programme and Results sheets. (PLEASE NOTE POOL SIDE PASSES DO NOT INCLUDE FOOD):  
£15 for both days.  
£8 for Saturday only.  
£8 for Sunday only  
Poolside Passes can be ordered with entries or on the day.
