

MEET RULES AND INFORMATION 1

1. The competition will be held under ASA Laws and ASA Technical Rules of Swimming. **This event is LICENSED at Level 1 (1EM8025) by the ASA for entry into National and Regional Championships.** Officials will be from National and Regional lists of the ASA.
2. For events with finals, the fastest ten swimmers from the heats, in each age group, will compete in the finals. There will be **NO RESERVES** used in finals.
3. The events are:
50m all 4 strokes **Open** age group only - heat declared
100m all 4 strokes 10/11 and 12/13 - heat declared,
14/15 and 16/Over - heats and finals
200m I.M. all age groups - heats and finals
200m all 4 strokes all age groups - heat declared
400m Freestyle **Open** age group only - heat declared
4. The age groups are:
10/11yrs, 12/13yrs, 14/15yrs, 16/Over, and Open
Ages as at the 13th January 2008.
5. The pool length is 50m, ten lane, and will be equipped with electronic timing with full display and anti-wave lane ropes.
6. Awards will be given to the **top three** placed swimmers in each age group in **each individual event.**
7. In addition to the individual event awards there will be the following overall awards:
A **Top Team** award
A **Best Supported** Team award
Top three Boy/Girl awards in each of the following ages:
10, 11, 12, 13, 14yrs Boys calculated using BAGCATs
10, 11, 12, 13yrs Girls calculated using BAGCATs
15yrs and Open Boys calculated using GB CATs
14, 15yrs and Open Girls calculated using GB CATs

The overall awards will be calculated as follows:
Top Boy 10 to 14 / Girl 10 to 13 years
BAG Points will be calculated for all swims by swimmers in the 10 to 13/14 years ages. These points will be accumulated into the appropriate BAG Category for each individual year age for both Boys and Girls. The overall top three swimmers in each of these BAGCATs will receive a Top Boy/Girl award.
Top Boy 15 and Open / Girl 14, 15 and Open
GB Points will be calculated for all swims by swimmers in the Boys 15 and Over and Girls 14 and Over ages. These points will be accumulated into the appropriate GB Category for each individual year age for **Boys 15yr and Open** and **Girls 14yr, 15yr and Open.** The overall top three swimmers in each of these GB Categories will receive a Top Boy / Girl award.
Top Team
Event Points will be scored for all events
The scoring will be:
1st 10 pnts, 2nd 9 pnts, 3rd 8 pnts, 4th 7 pnts, 5th 6 pnts
6th 5 pnts 7th 4 pnts 8th 3 pnts 9th 2 pnts 10th 1 pnt.
Event points will be accumulated for all swimmers (from all age groups), for each Club. The overall Top Club will receive a cash award.
Best Supported Team
This award will be made at the discretion of the promoters.

If there is a tie for any of these awards then the prizes will be shared.
8. Heats will be swum with age groups combined and swimmers seeded by entry times. **Entries must be within (ie equal to or faster than) the published qualifying times** for each event. These entries will be accepted on a **first come first served basis.** As similar amounts of entries may not be received for each session, the start time of the second session on each day is subject to change (earlier or later) and will be confirmed after the closing date. However if a session is excessively oversubscribed relative to the other session on the same day the promoters reserve the right to reject some of the slowest entries, at their discretion. If this is necessary, where possible the numbers accepted for each age group will be kept to the same proportions as the number of entries for each age group. For this purpose the Open events will be assessed by the following age groups, 10/11yrs, 12/13yrs, 14/15yrs and 16/Over.
9. Over the top starts will be used at the promoters discretion.
10. **The Entry Fee is £5.00 per event.** All entries must be on the official entry form (photocopies accepted), and **MUST** include the entrants ASA registration number together with all entry fees. **Please submit 25m entry times.** No entries will be accepted after the closing date unless due to promoters error or omission. Entries will not be registered unless accompanied by the correct entry fee. Cheques payable to **CITY OF DERBY S.C.**
11. Closing date for entries is **21st November 2007.**
12. Competitors times will be computer processed and results sheets will be on sale at 50p per session. Full sets can be posted at a cost of £3.00, or downloaded after the event.
13. Spectator admission prices:

All Day Saturday Adult £6 O.A.P. £3
All Day Sunday Adult £6 O.A.P. £3
Daily Programme £2
14. Coaches Passes and Pool Side Passes are available to Coaches supporting competing swimmers. They include a Programme and Results Sheets. **Maximum of 3 per club,** (or maximum of 1 for every 10 swimmers).
Coaches Pass including food pre-ordered with entries:
£17 for both Saturday and Sunday including lunch.
£10 for Saturday or Sunday only including lunch.
Coaches Passes must be ordered with entries to assist with catering and will be issued with the entry cards.
Pool Side Passes bought on the day will include a Programme and Results sheets (No food included):
£12 for both Saturday and Sunday.
£6 for Saturday or Sunday only
15. Any conditions not covered in the above will be at the discretion of the promoters **City of Derby SC.**
