Please note that in order to comply with the requirements of our Level 1 License, **entries for this meet must be within (ie equal to or faster than) the published qualifying times** for each event.

In certain circumstances the promoters reserve the right to restrict the number of entries by rejecting entries. (See Meet Rules and Information, particularly **rule 8**, for full details).

If over subscribed, entries with the slowest times will be rejected, even if they meet the Qualifying Times. First Come First Served is unfortunately not permitted for Level 1 meets any longer.

- 50m events have HDW, Open age group ONLY
- 100m events are HDW for the 10 & 11/12 ages, but have finals in the 13/14 & 15/Over ages
- 200m IM all ages have finals
- 200m Free, Breast, Fly and Back all ages HDW
- 400m Free all ages HDW
- Top Boy/Girl decided by BAGCATs and GB CATs
